- National Requirement practices must do:
 - Provide an opportunity for patients to give anonymous feedback through the FFT
 - Use the standard wording of the FFT question and the responses
 - Include at least one follow up question which allows the opportunity to provide free text -Patient suggestion "What single change in the services offered by College Lane would most improve your quality of life".
 - Submit data to NHS England each month & publish results

 The wording of the question must be as follows:

"We would like you to think about your recent experience of our service.

How likely are you to recommend our GP practice to friends and family if they needed similar care or treatment?"

The responses to the question must be:

- Likely
- Neither likely nor unlikely
- Unlikely
- Extremely unlikely
- Don't know
